This course is open to trebles and sopranos aged nine to sixteen years. It is a real chance to make good use of some of the Easter holidays. Here are some of the reasons to encourage you to be one of around 100 choristers who attend the Oxford Three-Day Course each year:

- To improve your singing of hymns, psalms, canticles, anthems and Easter carols.
- To learn new music.
- To improve your tone, diction, breath control, and phrasing.
- To enjoy singing in the beautiful acoustic of an Oxford College Chapel.
- To receive expert tuition from first-rate musicians.
- To meet choristers from other churches and compare notes.
- To meet friends from previous courses, and to make new friends on this one.
- To have a chance to win a scholarship to a one-week RSCM Residential Course, if aged 14 or under (up to two such awards may be made at the end of this course).

Each day's programme will begin at 9.30 a.m. and end with a service in New College Chapel at 4.15 p.m. All the music you need will be provided. Robes will be worn, but members of unrobed choirs are equally welcome. (Please inform the Administrator if you require robes,)

Choir Trainers and clergy are specially invited to attend practices in New College Chapel as well as the daily service. Choir Trainers who wish to observe the training sessions are most welcome to do so, provided that they obtain prior consent by contacting the Course Director, Mr Jonathan White, and in the case of the house sessions, the Housemaster, in person at the beginning of the session. Please make the course widely known and bring as many people as you can to the services.

The fee for the three days is £42 per chorister. This does not include refreshments – you will need to bring a packed lunch and tea, but soft drinks will be provided. The fee must accompany the applications form.

Places are limited so do apply early. If we cannot accept an entry, either completely or in part, a refund of the appropriate amount will be made. No refunds will be made if places are cancelled after the closing date. Joining instructions and music list will be sent with the acknowledgement of places.

We may wish to take photographs or videos of events for publication in Church Music Quarterly or elsewhere. Please enquire of parents whether they would have any objection to this, in which case we would be careful to give effect to parental wishes. There will be an opportunity to confirm this on the Parental Permission Sheet but it would be helpful to have an indication of this with the Application. Proper discretion would of course be observed at all times.
