Music will be available shortly. Choir trainers are asked to ensure that their singers are note-perfect before the rehearsals.

Robed and unrobed choirs are equally welcome. Cassocks should be worn only for the rehearsal and service on 9th October, not for the pre-Festival rehearsals.
